**DECLARATION ENDING THE STATE OF EMERGENCY AND ENDING THE DAILY CURFEW**

**WHEREAS,** City of Sumter City Code section 54-2 authorizes the Mayor to declare and proclaim the end of a state of emergency previously declared by the Mayor and the end of a curfew previously declared by the Mayor; and

**WHEREAS,** as Mayor, I find, based on credible information today provided by City administration and City law enforcement, that the previous situation of threats to persons and property and threats of disorder within the City has de-escalated and it is now appropriate to end the state of emergency and curfew previously declared and imposed by my Declaration of June 3, 2020,


**NOW, THEREFORE, AS MAYOR OF THE CITY OF SUMTER, I DECLARE THE FOLLOWING:**

1. The state of emergency previously declared by my Declaration of June 3, 2020, is now declared to be ended.
2. The City-wide daily curfew previously declared by my Declaration of June 3, 2020, is now declared to be ended.

This Declaration shall become effective immediately.
